## CONTEXT

The **Barcelona Beer Challenge** is an internationally recognised competition that has contributed to, along with other initiatives, providing a new platform of visibility and recognition to the best quality beers. This fifth edition of the contest (2020), is born out of the desire to continue to promote and publicise the beer industry.

And so the BBC competition was born under the organizational umbrella of the Barcelona Beer Festival: the main sector event in the entire country, and one of the most important in south Europe, attracting **35,000 visitors** in one weekend and hosting the best national and international breweries. The synergy between the contest and the festival has resulted in a meaningful media impact, enabling the message to reach the public as a result of the attention received by the press.







## 2019 EDITION

The 2019 BBC edition was attended by **218 breweries**, submitting **1.112 beers** to the competition, from **22 different countries**, spread across the categories (34) in the **BJCP catalogue**.

This is a reflection of the successful participation rates of this contest, solidifying the fact that these awards recognize, **certify** and publicise the highest standards in **beer quality**. The awards are presented by a trained and qualified jury, meaning that their decisions are in line with national and international standards of recognition for those receiving a **prize**.

In addition, for those breweries who were **awarded** prizes, this has meant the opening up of **new markets**, improving packaging with the **winner's logo**, and therefore the generation of new **promotional** material.

## JURY

The BBC's organisers are committed to the professionalization of the sector, which is why the **jury** will be comprised of **national and international** judges, all of whom are holders of the BJCP certificate (Beer Judge Certification Program). The BJCP certification program, launched in 1985, requires recipients to pass rigorous theoretical and practical tests and is an indispensable requirement for the selection of judges amongst the most prestigious festivals globally.

In this way, we are able to ensure a **professional jury**, with the certified skills and abilities to taste, evaluate and score beer in a **competitive context**.

### STORAGE AND SERVICE

All the references admitted to the contest will be cold-stored, using an intern codes system (related to evaluation group) In this way, we guarantee the best conditions for service and evaluation of the beers.





# AWARDS

## Types of awards:

The breweries will receive **recognition** for its valued beers, which will materialize in some different **awards** endowed with the legitimacy granted by a jury selected and recognized internationally.

The **Barcelona Beer Challenge** prizes are divided into four categories:

**Awards for the best beer by style.** Contemplated in the contest. Consists of Gold, Silver and Bronze medals. These prizes will be awarded taking into account the quality of the beer and will consider parameters such as: aroma, flavours, mouth feel, appearance, absence of defects; as well as the adaptation to the style to which beer is ascribed

**Award for the best brewer.** This prize will be awarded the set of beers presented by the same brewer, and who obtains more points among all the beers, at the rate of: 2 points for a bronze medal, 3 for a silver medal and 5 for a gold medal.

**Award for best rookie brewery.** This award recognizes and visualizes the best Rookie Brewery (\*). This prize will be awarded to the Rookie brewery that obtains more points among all beers presented, at the rate of: 2 points per bronze medal achieved, 3 points per silver medal achieved, 5 points per gold medal achieved.

\* Rookie Brewery: Brewery that starts the commercialization of its beer after January 1, 2018.

**Award for innovation Molina for Brewers :** We want to inspire you to explore new work territories as we present a prize in recognition of innovation in the creative process of beer making.

The prize, inspired by Molina for Brewers, aims to motivate you to leave your everyday ways of working behind and begin to innovate in the sector. Each participating brewery will choose one of the beers they have entered and explain the innovation it shows in a text alongside the entry. In the first stage, the Steering Committee will choose five finalists to be presented to judges with specific beer innovation knowledge who will choose a winner for the prize

The prizes will be announced and will be awarded in a public ceremony, within acts of **Barcelona Beer Festival 2020**.

La cervesera La Pirata, de Súria, va guanyar ahir la quarta edició del Barcelona Beer Challenge, amb la participació de 218 cerveses i un total de 1.112 cerveses diferents de 22 països d'arreu del món. El concurs es va fer en el marc del Barcelona Beer Festival, que va tancar la seva vuitena edició amb l'assistència rècord de 35.000 persones. Al llarg d'aquests tres dies, el públic que va acostar-se al recinte de La Farga de l'Hospitalet de Llobregat va poder tastar més de 600 cerveses artesanes de 314 cerveseries diferents. Força locals i bars barcelonins ien també concursos durant les nits.

## La madrileña, península, mejor cervecera novel en el Barcelona Beer Festival

La cervecera barcelonesa La Pirata ha sido elegida entre más de 200 cerveceras de todo el mundo como la Mejor Cervecera 2019 en el concurso que tiene lugar en el Barcelona Beer Festival, que este domingo cierra sus puertas, mientras que la madrileña Península ha sido reconocida como Mejor Cervecera Novel.

Según ha informado el festival, por categorías se han llevado las tres medallas de oro Samsa (American Amber Ale), Ibad Decision (Irisian Imperial Stout) y Naldia Winter (Seasonal Beer), mientras que Samsa ha sido reconocida con una medalla de bronce (Stone Ale).

La cuarta edición del Barcelona Beer Challenge 2019, el concurso de cerveza artesana de calidad más relevante del sur de Europa, ha concluido este año con la participación de 218 cerveceras y un total de 1.112 cervezas diferentes de 22 países de todo el mundo.

El jurado estaba integrado por 52 miembros, todos ellos homologados con la Oblicación Internacional BACP, de los cuales la mitad procedían de fuera de España.

El Barcelona Beer Challenge ha distinguido las mejores cervezas artesanas (Gran Pilsa y Bronco) en 48 categorías diferentes y ha otorgado los trofeos especiales a la Mejor Cervecera 2019 a Cerveza La Pirata (Súria, Barcelona) y a la Mejor Cervecera Novel 2019, que ha recaído en Cerveza Península (Alcalá de Henares, Madrid).

## Cervezas Arriaca obtiene 3 medallas en el certamen internacional Barcelona Beer Challenge

La cervecera arriaca Arriaca ha obtenido una Medalla de Oro y dos Medallas de Plata en la cuarta edición del Barcelona Beer Challenge 2019. Un concurso internacional celebrado en el marco del Barcelona Beer Festival, en el que han participado 1.112 cervezas de 22 países de todo el mundo, en total, en el concurso, participaron más prestigiosos del país. La Medalla de Oro ha sido para la Imperial Red IPA de Arriaca, en la respectivamente competitiva y disputada.
